Born in McAllen, Texas, in 1985, Clinton Broyles spent his formative years in the Dallas area, where he developed an interest in art at an early age. Broyles went on to study at Texas A&M University, earning a bachelor's degree in architecture in 2007. The architectural curriculum introduced him to concepts of design, structure, and space, which became recurring elements in his artwork.

Broyles' work reflects his interest in history, focusing on scenes from everyday life in bygone eras. His paintings are characterized by detailed compositions that highlight the aesthetics of the past while maintaining a contemporary and optimistic perspective. He is currently represented by the Southwest Gallery in Dallas and New Masters Gallery in Carmel.

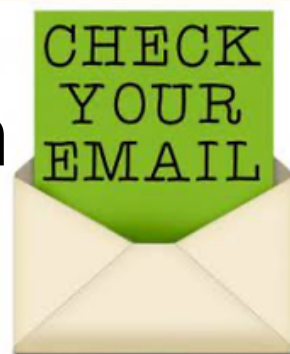

Artwork must be framed with d-rings attached at the back of the frame and strung with wire. See pictures below. This is the way all museums hang artwork today.

Any work submitted by someone who attended a class but is not yet a member of The Art Department and Woman's Club can enter as Exhibition Only.

Signature Status – This is a separate category for those artists who by points have achieved Signature Status. These entries will be judged separately with one piece being presented as Premier Signature Artist 2025.

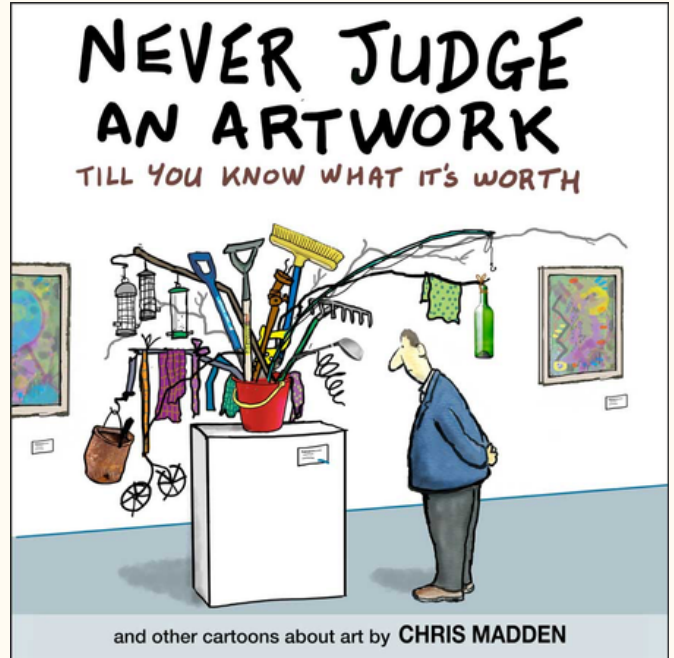
