Woman's Club Board

- Congratulate our new President Sheila Reynolds and her board for the 26-28 Woman's Club.

A new registration policy has been put in place for 26-27.

Old Policy – “Class Registration, Section 3” (page 43 in the Directory)

A member currently enrolled in an instructed class shall be assured enrollment in the same class in the consecutive semester providing the tuition in full is submitted by scheduled registration deadline.

Approved Policy 3-30-26

A member currently enrolled in an instructed class shall be assured enrollment in the same class in the consecutive semester providing the tuition in full is submitted within fourteen (14) days of the initial registration date. The enrollment shall be open on the 14th day to all Art Department members. (Example – The registration start date is April 15th; the current class member has until April 28 at 12 PM to complete their registration. The open registration period shall start on April 29.

Purpose for the Update

All registration should be completed within 45 days of the initial registration date. A shorter “protected timeframe” is required to allow all Art Department members an opportunity to get into a class within the registration deadline.

Art Department & Women of the Arts Registration

Non-Members may take only one class. After that, they are required to join the Woman's Club of Fort Worth to continue with any classes or to be a continuing member of the Art Department and Women of the Arts. For more information, reach out to any Board member in your class.

Our Teachers

Melinda Morrison - Wednesday

Class is designed for students who have experience in oil painting. It is grounding in the painting fundamentals that guide students in solving pictorial challenges using value, distinct shapes, composition, color, texture and edges. Students may use oils, gouache, or acrylics, with oils receiving primary emphasis. Students work from photographs and learn how to interpret them as effective paintings. Students are supported through individual progress critiques, demonstrations, and focused art content.



James Spurlock - Thursday

James Spurlock is our newest artist to come on board as a teacher. The fall of 2026 he will be teaching the pastel class. James is an all-around artist who paints in every medium. His beautiful pastel portraits display his ability with pastels. His tag is 'Art is just a series of adjustments.....and Life is Art'.



Linda McCall - Tuesday & Thursday

Essentials of Oil/Acrylic Painting – Beginner to Intermediate

Designed for the beginner student who desires to learn the basic oil painting skills, techniques, and art theory. Those with some experience will be guided to improve and troubleshoot problems in your work. All will begin to develop your own personal art style as you polish and mature your skills. Prior basic drawing skills are encouraged.

Elevate Your Painting – Designed for students who have experience in oil/acrylic painting.

This is a concentrated open painting class backed by instructor demonstration and personalized instruction. This session provides guidance to help you identify and focus on the painters' desired goals; troubleshoot your work and take your painting to the next level. Prior experience at this intermediate level in painting is a prerequisite to this class.



Bev Boren - Tuesday

Bev Boren is an all around artist. She can paint in all mediums with drawing at its foundation. Bev has settled into watercolor where she teaches students to 'let the water work for you.' Her encouragement helps students to loosen up with their work and use a different perspective in critiquing their own work. Not only does Bev teach a wonderful watercolor class but she inspires us all to learn to draw. It is the foundation of all art.
